$$2. \quad \frac{1}{4} \times \frac{2}{3} = \frac{2}{12} = \frac{1}{6}$$

$$7. \quad \frac{4}{9} \times \frac{1}{6} = \frac{4}{54} = \frac{2}{27}$$

$$17. \quad \frac{1}{2} \div \frac{3}{4} = \frac{1}{2} \times \frac{4}{3} = \frac{4}{6} = \frac{2}{3}$$

$$8. \quad \frac{1}{3} \div \frac{4}{5} = \frac{1}{3} \times \frac{5}{4} = \frac{5}{12}$$

$$18. \quad \frac{1}{5} \div \frac{5}{8} = \frac{1}{5} \times \frac{8}{5} = \frac{8}{25}$$

$$9. \quad \frac{4}{9} \times \frac{1}{2} = \frac{4}{18} = \frac{2}{9}$$

$$19. \quad \frac{4}{7} \div \frac{8}{9} = \frac{4}{7} \times \frac{9}{8} = \frac{36}{56} = \frac{9}{14}$$

$$10. \quad \frac{3}{4} \times \frac{2}{9} = \frac{6}{36} = \frac{1}{6}$$

$$20. \quad \frac{2}{9} \div \frac{1}{2} = \frac{2}{9} \times \frac{2}{1} = \frac{4}{9}$$
