$$1. \quad \frac{1}{5} + \frac{4}{10} = \frac{2}{10} + \frac{4}{10} = \frac{6}{10} = \frac{3}{5}$$

$$2. \quad \frac{1}{7} + \frac{6}{14} = \frac{2}{14} + \frac{6}{14} = \frac{8}{14} = \frac{4}{7}$$

$$3. \quad \frac{1}{3} + \frac{2}{6} = \frac{2}{6} + \frac{2}{6} = \frac{4}{6} = \frac{2}{3}$$

$$4. \quad \frac{4}{7} + \frac{4}{14} = \frac{8}{14} + \frac{4}{14} = \frac{12}{14} = \frac{6}{7}$$

$$5. \quad \frac{2}{7} + \frac{3}{14} = \frac{4}{14} + \frac{3}{14} = \frac{7}{14} = \frac{1}{2}$$

$$6. \quad \frac{3}{7} + \frac{6}{14} = \frac{6}{14} + \frac{6}{14} = \frac{12}{14} = \frac{6}{7}$$

$$7. \quad \frac{2}{3} + \frac{2}{12} = \frac{8}{12} + \frac{2}{12} = \frac{10}{12} = \frac{5}{6}$$

$$8. \quad \frac{1}{4} + \frac{5}{12} = \frac{3}{12} + \frac{5}{12} = \frac{8}{12} = \frac{2}{3}$$

$$9. \quad \frac{1}{9} + \frac{10}{18} = \frac{2}{18} + \frac{10}{18} = \frac{12}{18} = \frac{2}{3}$$

$$10. \quad \frac{1}{4} + \frac{11}{20} = \frac{5}{20} + \frac{11}{20} = \frac{16}{20} = \frac{4}{5}$$
