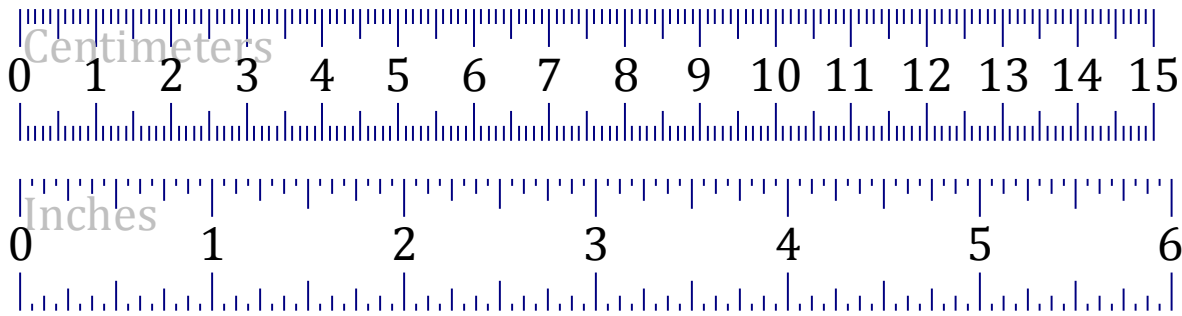


# Converting Inches to Centimeters (C)
